The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Ivanhoe Irrigation District was called to order by President Gary Caviglia, March 9, 2021 at 1:30 p.m.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director DeLeonardis, the Minutes of the February 9, 2021 Board Meeting were approved.

BILLS

The bills were reviewed by the Board. Upon a motion by Director Peltzer and seconded by Director DeLeonardis, check numbers 15466-15519, inclusive and included herewith as Attachment "A" were approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the attached financial report for the March 9, 2021 Board Meeting, were submitted to the Board of Directors showing receipts of \$12,919.28, total disbursements of \$337,673.85 and an active bank balance of \$582,577.88 at Citizens Business Bank ending February 28, 2021 for their review. Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director Felts, the financial report was approved.

WATER SUPPLY

It was reported that there was no water delivered in the month of February with 0.53 inches of rain for the month and 3.55 inches of rain season to date.

It was reported that the ASO flight revealed close to 60,000 acre-feet less than the Bureau had initially anticipated in the watershed.

Manager Weddle reported inflow into Lake Kaweah was much less than the prior year at the same time and that this would mean lower Longs and Wutchumna water entitlement. He also stated that additional water would cost between \$1700-\$2000 per acre-foot.

#### SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

Mark Davis informed the Board that Vollmer had replaced close to 2,700 feet of lateral lines this off season.

#### GROUNDWATER LEVELS

The average depth to groundwater for the month of March was reported at 105.0 feet. This was a decrease in the depth to water of 0.4 feet from the prior month.

#### 68 SCADA PROJECT

Upon a motion by Director Paregien and seconded by Director Phillips, Progress Payment No. 6 to Nicholas Construction of \$153,900 was approved.

Upon a motion by director Peltzer and seconded by Director Spruitenburg, the Board authorized Engineer Dennis Keller to set the bid date for the SCADA integration.

#### SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ACT

It was reported that water monitoring would transition from CASGEM to a new groundwater monitoring module through SGMA.

#### SOUTH VALLEY WATER ASSOCIATION

Dan Vink gave a quick update of South Valley activities reminding the Board that the Settlement would be reopened in 2025 for review.

#### CLOSED SESSION

Alex Peltzer took the Board into closed session to talk about existing litigation.
