The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Ivanhoe Irrigation District was called to order by President Gary Caviglia, July 13, 2021, at 1:30 p.m.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director Peltzer, the Minutes of the June 8, 2021, Board Meeting were approved.

The bills were reviewed by the Board. Upon a motion by Director Paregien and seconded by Director Spruitenburg, check numbers 15655-15693, inclusive and included herewith as Attachment "A" were approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the attached financial report for the July 13, 2021, Board Meeting, were submitted to the Board of Directors showing receipts of \$142,638.41, total disbursements of \$174,458.96, and an active bank balance of \$455,790.09 at Citizens Business Bank ending June 30, 2021, for their review. Upon a motion by Director Peltzer and seconded by Director Felts, the financial report was approved.

WATER SUPPLY

The District delivered 280 AF of CVP and 464 AF of Wutchumna in the month of June. There was no rain for the month, for a season total of 5.29 inches of rain for the season.

It was reported that the Bureau allocation was still at 20%.

SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

Manager Weddle reported that deliveries were going as planned with a few repairs as needed.

GROUNDWATER LEVELS

The average depth to groundwater for the month of July was reported at 114.7 feet. This was an increase in the depth to water of 3.7 feet from the prior month.

68 SCADA PROJECT

There was nothing new to report on the 68 SCADA Project.

MANAGERS REPORT

Manager Weddle received authorization to bump Curt Dreos's hourly rate up to \$15 an hour.

SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ACT

It was reported that the East Kaweah GSA was working through whether to allocate groundwater pumping to only those acres that are current groundwater pumpers or to all non-industrial acres.

SOUTH VALLEY WATER ASSOCIATION

Dan Vink informed the Board that Biden's Infrastructure Bill would appropriate \$5 billion for west wide water projects if passed.

CLOSED SESSION

There was no Closed Session.
