Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director DeLeonardis, the Minutes of the December 14, 2021, Board Meeting were approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the attached financial report for the January 11, 2022, Board Meeting, were submitted to the Board of Directors showing receipts of \$604,934.74, total disbursements of \$98,993.90, and an active bank balance of \$1,262,080.63 at Citizens Business Bank ending December 31, 2021, for their review. WATER SUPPLY

The District delivered no CVP and no Wutchumna in the month of December. There was a 4.78 in of rain for the month of December.

SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

Chris Marshall informed the Board that in December they have been servicing meters, repairing leaks, and recharging reservoirs.

GROUNDWATER LEVELS

The average depth to groundwater for the month of January was reported 113.2 feet. This was a decreased in the depth to water of 1.6 feet from the prior month.

MANAGERS REPORT

Motion to bring Rob WDM to update and create manual for water software and establish a report to connect APN/Meters for future EKGSA request. Upon a motion by Director DeLeonardis and seconded by Director Spruitenburg.

Consulting Engineer Dennis Keller provided and reviewed a memo to the Board documenting his findings resulting in the recommendation that the Board make an emergency declaration with regard to the need to replace the District office domestic well. Engineer Keller noted that these finding are the basis for the Board to invoke emergency procedures associated with the immediate replacement of the well. On motion of Director DeLeonardis, seconded by Director Peltzer, the Board adopted the emergency declaration and instructed staff to proceed with replacement of the well.
