The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Ivanhoe Irrigation District was called to order by President Gary Caviglia, February 9, 2021 at 1:30 p.m.

OTHERS PRESENT: Manager Weddle (by phone), Arely Egger, Michael Hagman, Andrew Hart, Matt Fisher, and Alex Peltzer (by phone)

PUBLIC COMMENT

Matt Fisher addressed the Board asking if it was within the Districts policies to allow pumping from one parcel in the District and use the District conveyance system to move the water to another parcel. The Board asked Mr. Fisher to explore other options that would include importing additional water into the District first.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director Peltzer, the Minutes of the January 12, 2021 Board Meeting were approved.

BILLS

The bills were reviewed by the Board. Upon a motion by Director Paregien and seconded by Director DeLeonardis, check numbers 15432-15465, inclusive and included herewith as Attachment "A" were approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the attached financial report for the February 9, 2021 Board Meeting, were submitted to the Board of Directors showing receipts of \$195,079.37, total disbursements of \$138,064.35 and an active bank balance of \$907,332.45 at Citizens Business Bank ending January 31, 2021 for their review. Upon a motion by Director Peltzer and seconded by Director Spruitenburg, the financial report was approved.

The Board reviewed the year-to-date expenditures.

WATER SUPPLY

It was reported that there was no water delivered in the month of January with 1.93 inches of rain for the month and 3.02 inches of rain season to date.

SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

Manager Weddle gave the Board a quick overview of the projects and repairs that were being worked on by staff.

GROUNDWATER LEVELS

The average depth to groundwater for the month of February was reported at 105.4 feet. This was a decrease in the depth to water of 2.4 feet from the prior month.

68 SCADA PROJECT

Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director DeLeonardis, Progress Payment No. 5 to Nicholas Construction of \$171,000 was approved.

SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ACT

Michael Hagman attended the Board Meeting to address questions and concerns that have been brought up over the past several months regarding SGMA and how the East Kaweah GSA plans to handle the State regulated program.

SOUTH VALLEY WATER ASSOCIATION

Alex Peltzer gave a short update on the Friant Kern Canal fix and the continued work on securing funding for the project.

Mr. Peltzer talked about the dryness of the current water season and how it would likely affect allocations to the West side and the Exchange Contractors.

There was also talk about a URF exchange with the West Side that would net the Friant Contractors an additional .25 acre foot of water for each 1 acre foot that was given up this winter for Restoration flows.

CLOSED SESSION

Alex Peltzer took the Board into closed session to talk about existing litigation.

The Board also discussed Manager Weddle's evaluation.

CLOSED SESSION

Coming out of Closed Session the Board approved a cost-of-living increase for Manager Weddle Retroactive to January 1 pending Exeter Irrigation District's decision to do the same.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, upon a motion presented by Director DeLeonardis and seconded by Director Spruitenburg, the meeting was adjourned at 3:20 p.m. The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Ivanhoe Irrigation District Board of Directors will be held Tuesday, March 9, 2021, at 1:30 pm.
