The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Ivanhoe Irrigation District was called to order by President Gary Caviglia, April 13, 2021 at 1:30 p.m.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director DeLeonardis, the Minutes of the March 9, 2021 Board Meeting were approved.

BILLS

The bills were reviewed by the Board. Upon a motion by Director Felts and seconded by Director Paregien, check numbers 15520-15563, inclusive and included herewith as Attachment "A" were approved.

The Board requested a breakdown of costs from Friant for the San Luis Delta Mendota and the O'Neil's Pumping Plant for the May Board Meeting.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the attached financial report for the April 13, 2021 Board Meeting, were submitted to the Board of Directors showing receipts of \$39,657.67, total disbursements of \$295,046.75, and an active bank balance of \$327,188.80 at Citizens Business Bank ending March 31, 2021 for their review. Upon a motion by Director Peltzer and seconded by Director Paregien, the financial report was approved.

WATER SUPPLY

The District delivered no water in the month of March and received 1.57 inches of rain for the month for a total of 5.12 inches of rain season to date. The District initial allocation was set at 0.35 acre-foot per acre at a cost of \$275 per acre-foot.

SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

Mark Davis informed the Board that he would be retiring from the District some time at the beginning of May.

GROUNDWATER LEVELS

The average depth to groundwater for the month of April was reported at 106.6 feet. This was an increase in the depth to water of 1.6 feet from the prior month.

MANAGERS REPORT

The Board discussed delinquent landowners that fall under the \$1 owed threshold. Consultant Engineer Keller informed the Board that the District could not exempt any landowners regardless of the amount owed.

SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ACT

Nick Keller addressed questions from the Board regarding East Kaweah policies and whether he felt that the GSA was headed in the right direction.

SOUTH VALLEY WATER ASSOCIATION

Dan Vink reviewed a bill introduced by Senator Feinstein that would provide \$180 million for the Friant Kern Canal fix.

CLOSED SESSION

There was no Closed Session.
