The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Ivanhoe Irrigation District was called to order by President Gary Caviglia, August 10, 2021, at 1:30 p.m.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Upon a motion by Director Phillips and seconded by Director Spruitenburg, the Minutes of the July 13, 2021, Board Meeting were approved with the change of “non-industrial”.

BILLS

The bills were reviewed by the Board. Upon a motion by Director Paregien and seconded by Director Spruitenburg, check numbers 15694-15735, inclusive and included herewith as Attachment “A” were approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT

Copies of the attached financial report for the August 10, 2021, Board Meeting, were submitted to the Board of Directors showing receipts of \$112,513.75, total disbursements of \$152,448.37, and an active bank balance of \$415,855.47 at Citizens Business Bank ending July 31, 2021, for their review. Upon a motion by Director DeLeonardis and seconded by Director Paregien, the financial report was approved.

WATER SUPPLY

The District delivered 768 AF of CVP and 301 AF of Wutchumna in the month of July. There was no rain for the month of July.

It was reported that the Bureau was going to borrow up to 200,000 AF from the state side of San Luis Reservoir to maintain the current 20% and supply any deficits that might occur for the Exchange Contractors. It was reported that the District received 250 AF from Lower Tule River Irrigation District that would need to be paid back at 2 for 1 prior to 2031.

SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT

GROUNDWATER LEVELS

The average depth to groundwater for the month of August was reported at 117.5 feet. This was an increase in the depth to water of 2.8 feet from the prior month.

68 SCADA PROJECT

It was reported that the project was completed.

MANAGERS REPORT

The Board discussed the possibility of putting in recharge wells.

SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT ACT

Manager Weddle told the Board that Lindmore Irrigation District was currently working through the process of putting in the recharge wells and has stated that while working through the details with the EPA, the EPA has stated that the final requirements will be under the jurisdiction of the County of Tulare.

SOUTH VALLEY WATER ASSOCIATION

Dan Vink talked about the Middle Reach Subsidence Project and the feasibility study, engineering, and benefits of the project.

CLOSED SESSION

The Board went into closed session at 2:45 without Manager Weddle to discuss his performance evaluation.
